For Garmin Software to operate correctly in the ICON A5, a configuration file (ICON 1.0) must also be loaded into the G3X. If the ICON 1.0 configuration file has been previously uploaded to the Garmin G3X, then skip steps 9 through 13.

NOTE: The file structure is important in the SD card. There should only be one parent folder titled “Garmin” with no other parent folders. In addition, the folder “config” should be inside the parent folder “Garmin”. Only the ICON 1.0 configuration file should be inside the “config” folder.

NOTE: Garmin may, from time to time, release new software versions shortly after the release of the one listed above. In those instances, the software version listed in this service letter will no longer be available on the Garmin download web page. Please refrain from updating the software onto the ICON A5 G3X until the released software from Garmin is validated by ICON Aircraft and a new Service Letter revision is released.

Updating G3X to Garmin Software Version 9.33

1. Download the Garmin software version 9.33 onto an SD card.
 - a. The software can be downloaded on the Garmin website [here](#).
 - b. Select: GDU 4xx Cockpit Display for your desired operating system.
 - c. Select your inserted SD card as the download location for the software.
 - d. Perform the following steps if the ICON 1.0 configuration file has not been previously loaded.
 - i. Once Garmin software version 9.33 has been downloaded, open the folder titled “Garmin”.
 - ii. Inside “Garmin” folder, create new folder titled “config”.
 - iii. Download ICON 1.0 configuration file and transfer it into the “config” file on the software SD card.

NOTE: The ICON 1.0 configuration file shall be obtained from an authorized ISP or ICON headquarters in Vacaville, California.

2. Ensure that aircraft master power is off.
3. Insert the SD card into the SD slot at the bottom of the Garmin G3X Touch display.

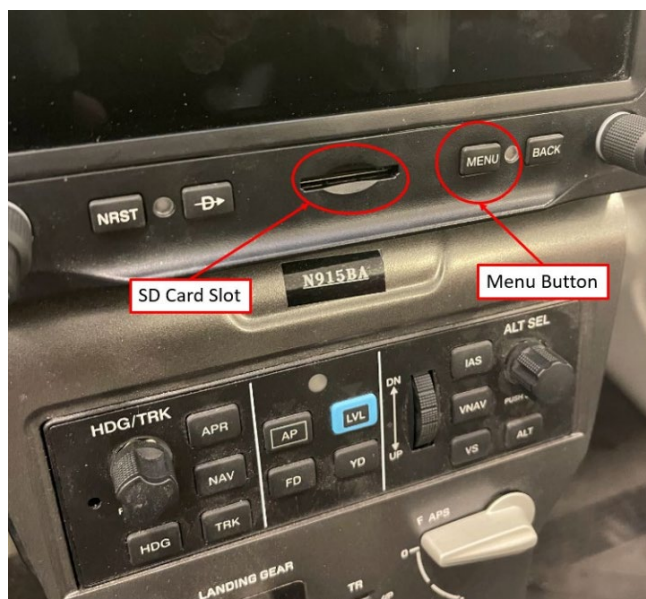


Figure 1. SD Card Slot and Menu Button

 - a. See Figure 1.

4. Turn on the aircraft master power and hold the Menu button to enter Configuration Mode.
 - a. See Figure 1.
5. When “Update Software” windows populates, select “Yes.”
 - a. See Figure 2.

NOTE: Software 9.13 is shown as an example in Figure 2. When downloaded, the latest version will be shown on the update screen on the G3X.

6. The Garmin G3X will automatically update the software.
 - a. DO NOT turn off the aircraft power until the software is fully updated.
 - i. The software is fully updated when the message “Software update in progress- Do not remove power” disappears.
 - ii. This can be found by selecting “Messages” at bottom of screen.

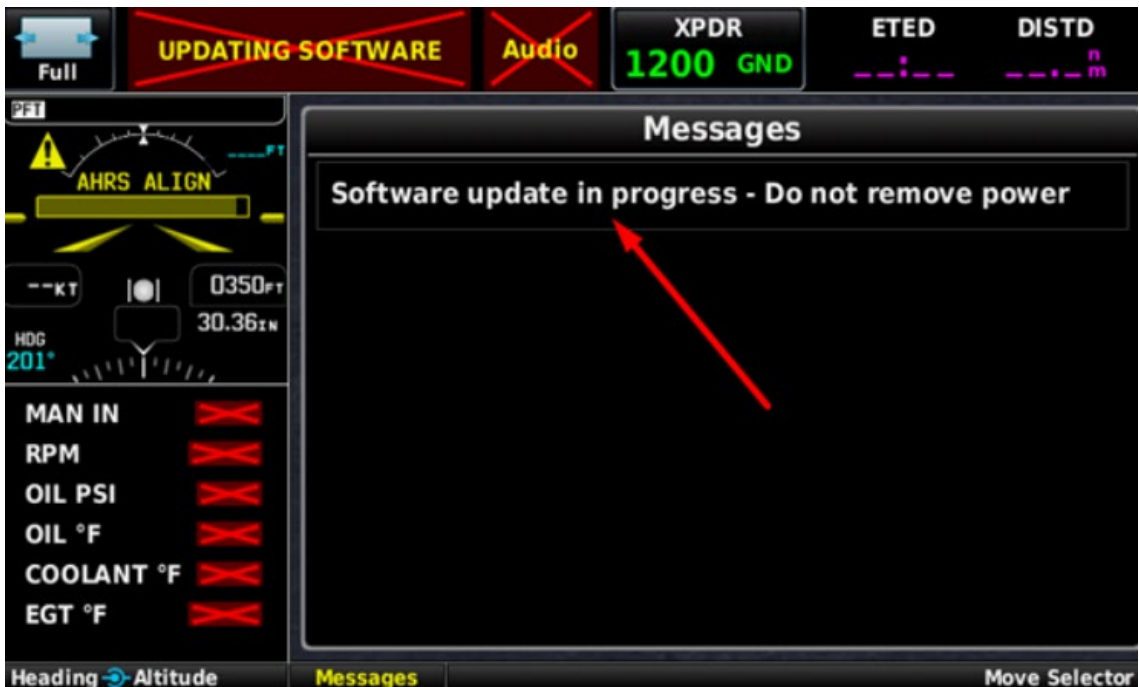
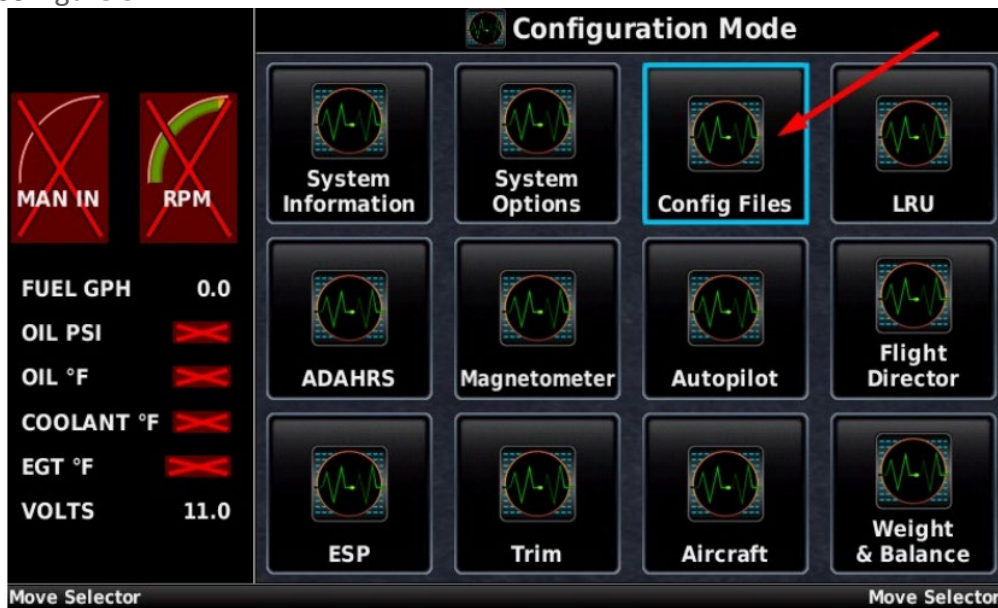


Figure 4. Update Message

 - b. See Figure 3 and Figure 4.

7. The update may last up to 20 minutes.
 - a. It is advised to place the aircraft on an appropriate external power supply during the update process.

8. Once the software is fully updated, reboot the G3X by,
 - a. Simultaneously holding the NRST, MENU, and BACK buttons.
 - b. Once the boot screen appears, hold only the MENU button until the configuration mode screen appears.

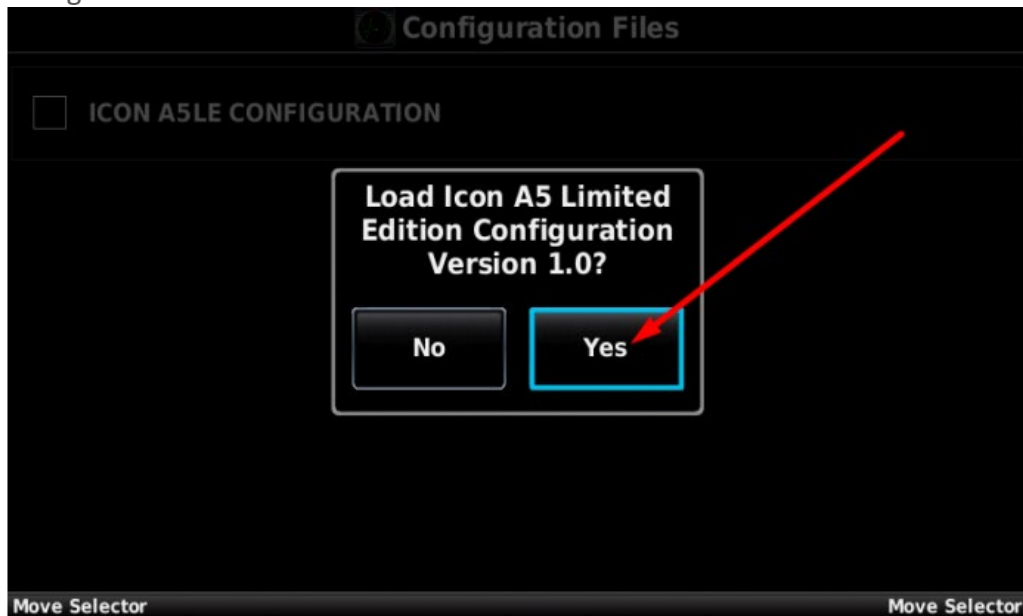
*Figure 5. Configuration Mode Screen*

 - i. See Figure 5.
9. Once in configuration mode, click “Config Files.”
 - a. See Figure 5.

10. The configuration file on the SD card will be shown.

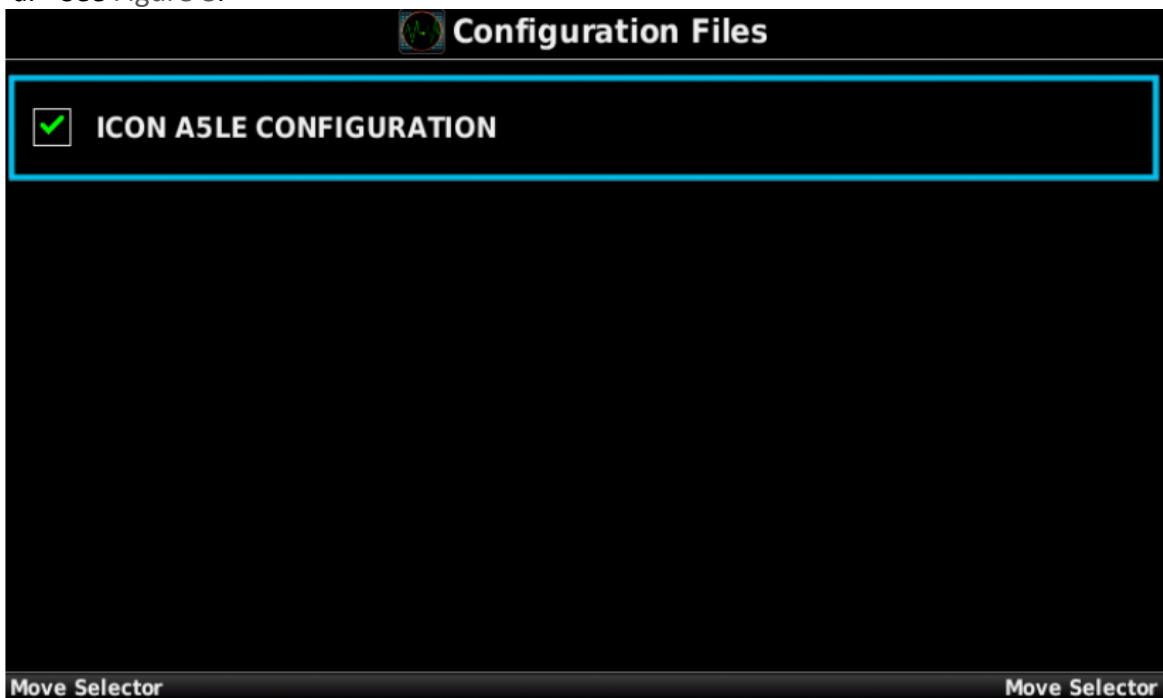
*Figure 6. ICON Configuration File*

 - a. See Figure 6.

11. Select “ICON A5LE CONFIGURATION.”
 - a. A prompt will appear; Select “Yes.”
 - b. See Figure 7.

13. Press the BACK button on the G3X touch display.
14. Select “System Information” to verify that the ICON 1.0 configuration file has been loaded.

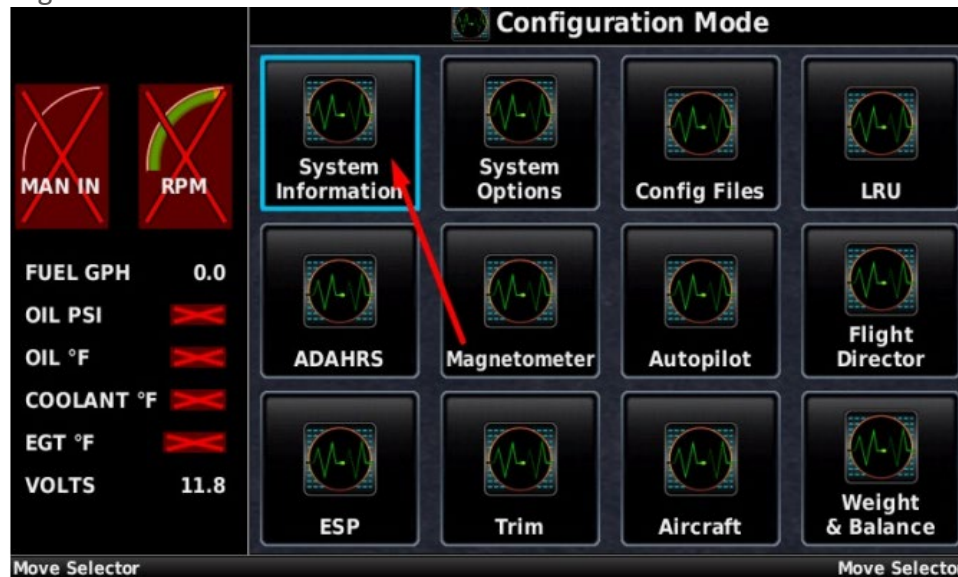


Figure 9. System Information

 - a. See Figure 9.

15. Confirm the Primary Flight Display Config Module indicates “Valid” with a green check mark and Config Version indicates “ICON 1.0.”

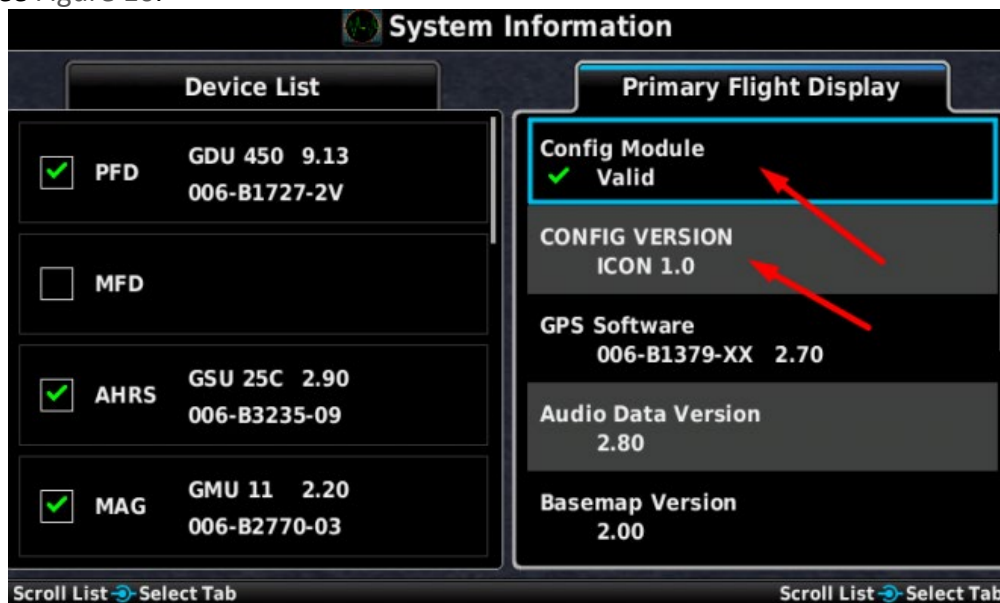


Figure 10. Confirmation of the ICON 1.0 File

 - a. See Figure 10.

16. Press the BACK button to return to the Configuration Mode page.
17. Select “Transponder” to go to Transponder Configuration page.

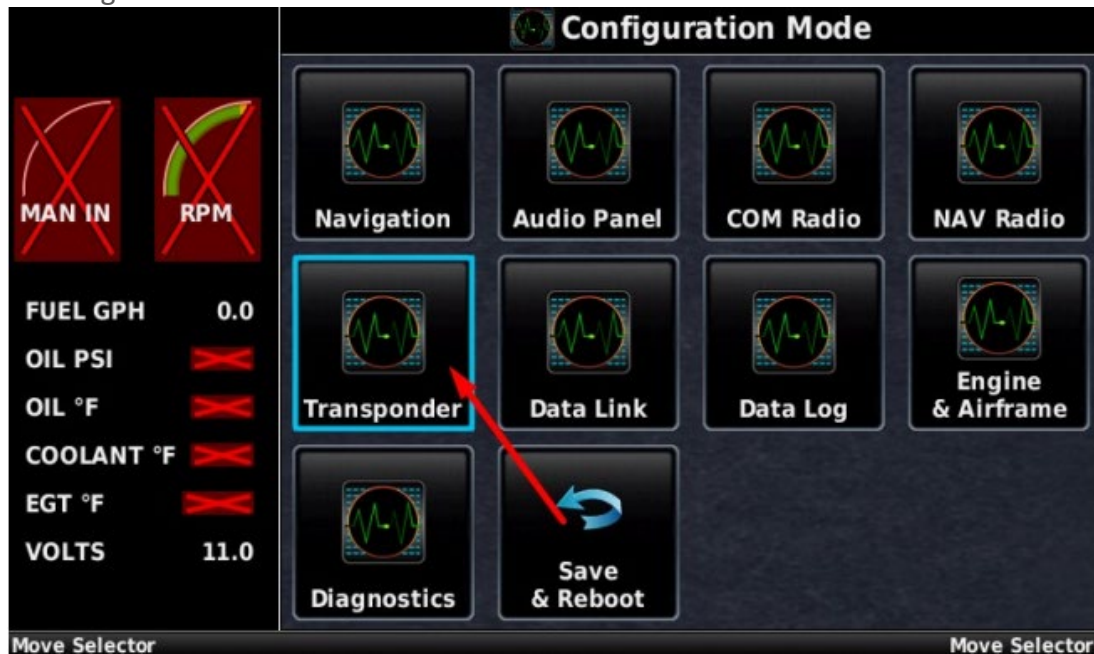


Figure 11. Transponder Configuration

 - a. See Figure 11.

18. On the right-side menu “Configuration”, scroll using swipe gestures to move the menu down. Continue until the option “Position Integrity” is shown.

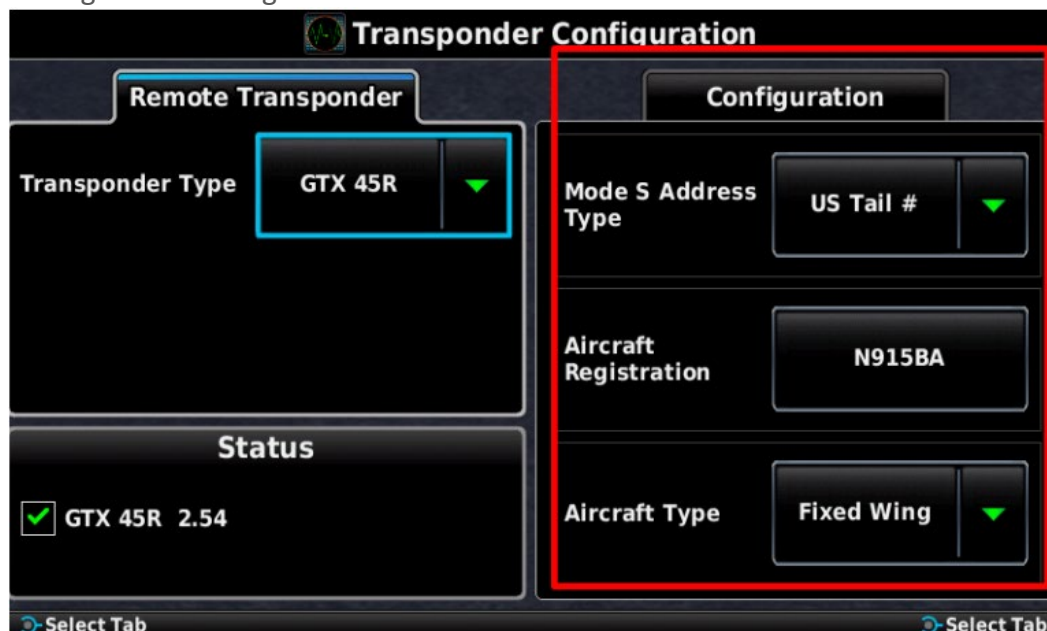


Figure 12. Set Position Integrity

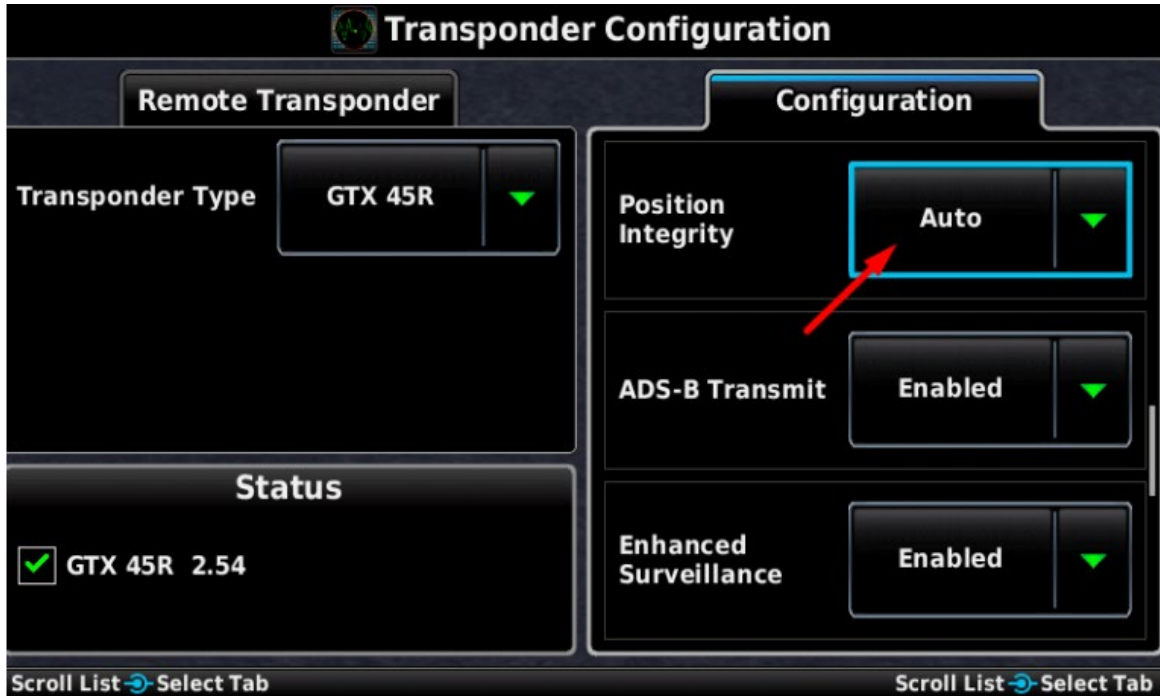


Figure 13. Set Position Integrity 2

 - a. See Figure 12 and Figure 13.

19. Select the drop-down menu for Position Integrity and select “IFR GPS 1e-7.”
 - a. See Figure 14.

20. Press the BACK button on the G3X Touch display to return to the Configuration Mode page.
21. Select “Save & Reboot.”
22. A prompt will appear; Select “Yes.”

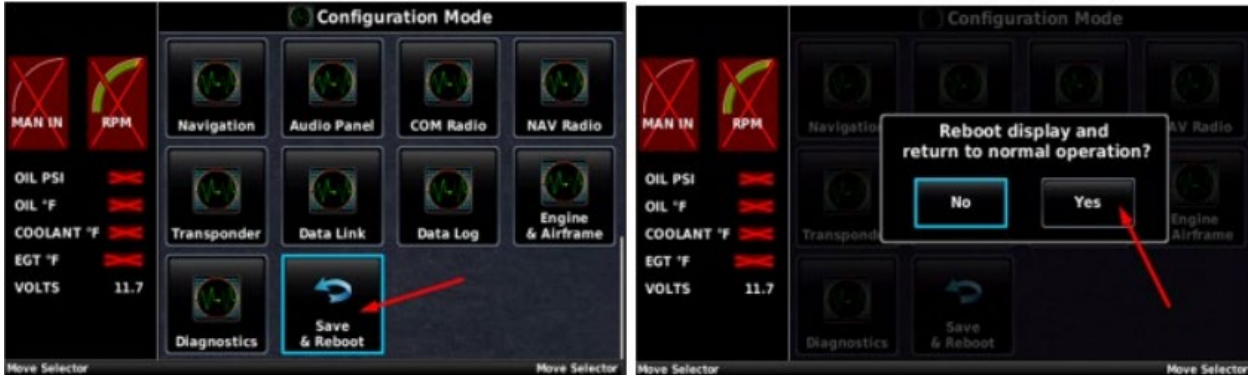


Figure 15. Reboot Display Page

 - a. See Figure 15.

- 23. The system will reboot.
 - a. Wait for the G3X system to return to the home page.
 - b. While rebooting, look at the bottom of the screen and ensure “Software Version 9.33” is displayed.
 - i. This will occur quickly and only display for a few seconds.
- 24. Turn off aircraft master power and remove the SD card from the G3X Touch display.
